HISTORICAL SKETCH

Founded in 2012, the goal of the Kansas City Zine Collective was to foster and grow the zine culture in Kansas City. In addition to zine distribution, the group gave workshops, hosted readings and exhibits, ran pop-up libraries, and visited classrooms. Following their launch of the first ever Kansas City Zine Con, the group disbanded, donating a hearty 914 zines to LaBudde Special Collections.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

The Kansas City Zine Collective Zine Collection was gifted to the LaBudde Special Collections in December 2015 by collective founders. The collection houses periodicals from 1976 to 2015, spanning eighteen series. It boasts both broad and niche subjects ranging from the “Perzine” (personal zines), to Anarchy, Fiction, Poetry, and Photography. This set provides a truly unique and all-encompassing view of D.I.Y. (Do It Yourself) culture both then and now.

SERIES NOTES

Series I: Personal

Undoubtedly the largest and most diverse series of the collection, personal zines have a plethora of topics and content types such as: editorials, music reviews, letter response, art, poetry, fiction, and more, all predominantly based upon the personal perspective of the author(s). Personal zines make up the heart of D.I.Y. culture, as almost every page is published by the writers themselves. Boxes 1-5, and Box 6, Folders 1-3.

Series II: Women/Feminism

This series contains publications specifically focused on women’s topics, including: Feminism, Women’s Health and Wellness, and History. Box 6, Folder 4, and Box 7.

Series III: Politics (General)

This series is comprised of publications exploring a variety of political issues. Topics of focus include rioting, civil rights, and political history. They contain interviews, letters, and editorials. Box 8, and Box 9, Folder 1.

Series IV: Anarchy

Though similar to Politics, this series is focused specifically on the ideology, history, and iconography of Anarchy. Box 9, Folders 2-4.

Series V: Prison Zines

By and for prisoners, this series is exclusively focused on issues regarding the prisoners themselves and the prison system. General discussion, letters, and poetry are all main components. Box 10. Folders 1-3.

Series VI: Informational

All about the “All About” and “How-to” genre, the series digs into topics ranging from papermaking and proper foraging techniques to a more sarcastic guide to modern etiquette. Box 10, Folder 4, and Box 11, Folders 1 and 2.

Series VII: Community

Series VII contains periodicals about groups. There are zines by art collectives, zines for librarians, and zines about the development of community within larger cities. Box 11, Folders 3-5, and Box 12, Folders 1 and 2.

Series VIII: LGBTQ

Zines in this series are specifically focused on LGBTQ topics, including history, personal anecdotes, and discussions of identity. Box 12, Folders 3-6.

Series IX: Comics

This series is comprised entirely of comic books. Some include illustrations and stories of personal experience, D.I.Y. superheroes, and collections of short comics from various authors as well as an adaptation of a Nathanael Hawthorne story. Boxes 13 and 14.

Series X: Music

These zines are geared mostly towards rock music. Ranging from 1995 to 2014, more than half of these periodicals are focused on and local to Kansas City. Box 15, Folders 1-4.

Series XI: History

This series contains publications on a variety of events and time periods, written to summarize or discuss events not current at the time of writing. Box 15, Folder 5, and Box 16, Folder 1.

Series XII: Food

This series is geared towards food and primarily includes cookbooks and information about food lifestyles, specifically Veganism. Box 16, Folder 2.

Series XIII: Art/Photography

This series contains exhibitive publications of concept art and photography. Some are collections from various artists and some are exclusive. They are occasionally centered on specific themes. Box 16, Folders 3-5.

Series XIV: Fiction

This series contains fiction short stories, novellas, and collections from various authors. Box 17, Folders 1-3.

Series XV: Nonfiction

This series contains short stories and collections from one or many authors. Box 17, Folder 4, and Box 18, Folder 1-5.

Series XVI: Poetry

This series contains collections of poetry from one or many poets, one of which also includes a CD recording of a live reading. Box 19, Folders 1 and 2.

Series XVII: Miscellaneous

Some notable additions to this divergent series include: Five Days in the Life of Applebee's, the "Kurt Cobain Was Lactose Intolerant Conspiracy Zine", and "Taking Back the Night" a zine about close encounters with extraterrestrials. Box 19, Folders 3 and 4, and Box 20, Folders 1-3.

Series XVIII: Media

This series includes two DVD copies of the film "A Hundred Dollars and a T-Shirt" as well as a poster. Box 20, Folder 4.
