BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

The Lavender Ladies is a social club for Kansas City area lesbians of all ages. The group meets on a monthly basis, and encompasses a number of different activities for members, including quilting, a book club, and various types of outings.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

The Lavender Ladies Collection was donated to the Gay and Lesbian Archive of Mid-America by decision of the organization's board members in June of 2011. It consists of materials collected by club members over time, including local, regional, and national publications; books; sound recordings; audio-visual materials; and t-shirts. While some of the books were added to LaBudde Special Collections (searchable in the Library's online catalog), the bulk were subsequently donated to the LIKE-Me Lighthouse, an LGBT community center in midtown Kansas City. T-shirts are housed with the Kansas City Museum, the GLAMA collaborating partner responsible for preserving donated artifacts. The collection features material related to the life and work of Jo-Pat Bishop, an early member of the organization, who was also active in Kansas City's theater community. She mounted theatrical productions at the Lavender Umbrella, located at 308 E. 43rd Street in Kansas City. In the late 1980s, the Lavender Umbrella served as a meeting space for the Lavender Ladies and other groups. Additionally, the collection contains an expansive array of lesbian- and feminist-oriented publications from the late 1950s through early 2000s, including such titles as *The Ladder* (published by the national lesbian advocacy organization Daughters of Bilitis), *Off Our Backs*, and *Sojourner*. Also housed within the collection are video and audio tapes of local programming from the early 1990s through the early 2000s that feature LGBT content, as well as a series of episodes of the nationally-syndicated television program *Network Q*. The collection contains a small quantity of photographs from the life and career of Jo-Pat Bishop and from various social activities of the organization.

SERIES NOTES

SERIES I: JO-PAT BISHOP

This series contains material related to the life and career of Jo-Pat Bishop, a member of the Lavender Ladies. Bishop had a career in local theater, and there are several theater programs as well as material from two productions she presented at the Lavender Umbrella, *My Blue Heaven* and *Lydia E. Pinkham's Menstrual Show*. There are samples of Bishop's writing and photographs from different phases of her life in this series as well.

SERIES II: PUBLICATIONS & PERIODICALS

Series II contains magazine and newspaper clippings; a variety of informational brochures and pamphlets; calendars; flyers from various local events; theatrical and other programs; random publications; and a vast array of LGBT- and non-LGBT-related commercial publications. Late 1960s and early 1970s lesbian and feminist titles are particularly well-represented in the periodicals, including almost a complete run of *The Ladder*, as well as a large number of issues of *Off Our Backs* and *Sojourner*. Of particular interest is the variety of smaller magazine titles produced locally and throughout the Midwest.

SERIES III: AUDIO-VISUAL MATERIALS

This series features recordings on VHS, audio-cassette, and DVD. Most feature topics related to the LGBT communities, and the video tapes include both homemade recordings of local and nationally-broadcast programming and commercially-issued tapes. The audio recordings are of several local radio shows, including encounters on local Christian-based radio programming. The audio-visual materials in the collection date from the early 1990s through the early 2000s.

SERIES IV: MISCELLANEOUS

Series IV contains a framed arrangement of table-top size Rainbow and Pink Triangle flags.

SERIES V: PHOTOGRAPHS

Photographs can be found in Box 1, Folder 6 and Box 2, Folder 8. The set in box 1 center on the life and activities of Jo Pat Bishop; in Box 2 are images of social events and other functions of the Lavender Ladies, including a number of images taken inside the Lavender Umbrella space.
