BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

A sign-up sheet for those interested in forming a Lesbian and Gay Community Center was presented to attendees at the 1992 Pride Festival, and from this emerged The Lesbian and Gay Community Center of Kansas City (LGCCCKC), which was incorporated by the end of the year. As stated in its bylaws, the purpose of the Center is “to establish and maintain a community center for the good of the lesbian and gay community and their friends; to provide a safe place in which person of that community can interact and grow educationally, emotionally, and spiritually; and to provide and support groups who will address the ongoing needs of the lesbian, gay and allied communities.” This mission was directly addressed initially by the development of “Councils” that addressed specific needs, e.g. Support Groups, Lesbian Alliance, Community Development, and Social Service. Out of these Councils grew several notable projects, including the Lydia Moore Lesbian Health Project and the Greater Kansas City Queer Community Oral History Project.

Outreach is a particular strength of the organization. The most notable example of these types of efforts was the “Out in Westport” event, held on the second Sunday in October to coincide with National Coming Out Day. Out in Westport began in 1994 as a combination community awareness fair and opportunity to patronize gay-owned and gay-friendly businesses in the district. Over time it grew in popularity, to the point that the fair component grew so large that Westport Road was shut down for the event. In the mid-2000s the event was relocated to Hyde Park, and dubbed “OutFest”, allowing the Center to continue to focus on its community awareness mission.

While primarily a service organization, the LGCCCKC also focused on providing members of the lesbian and gay community a physical space in which to congregate. In 1993, the Center leased office space in the Westport Allen Center. By 1999, a “transitional office” called The Rainbow Center was launched on the second floor of the Supreme Bean Coffee House at 1615 W. 39th Street. In 2004 the Center moved into a space at 205 Westport Road, where it remained until July of 2008, when the LGCCCKC migrated to an exclusively online existence at www.lgccckc.org where it remains as of this writing (Jan, 2011).

SCOPE AND CONTENT

The LGCCKC Collection was gifted to the LaBudde Special Collections in February 2010 by Dan Melton, former Treasurer and Development Officer of the organization. The collection contains a great deal of documentation related the early history of the Center, including Board minutes, Friends of the Community Center minutes, and a Board Notebook. In addition, there is a large amount of material related to Out in Westport and other outreach activities, and a good collection of Center newsletters is present as well.

Unexpectedly, the Collection is very strong in material from other organizations, e.g. brochures, newsletters, etc. This likely stems from the Center's role as a clearinghouse of information for the gay and lesbian community. In addition, there are a substantial number of commercial and activist publications, from the Kansas City area and across the United States. Many date from the late 1960s and early 1970s, and most are from the lesbian and feminist communities.

SERIES NOTES

SERIES I: BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Series I is contained in Box 1 and folders 1-3 in Box 2. It features minutes and agendas from Board meetings from 1992 through 2003 (sparse in later years), a Board Notebook that was presented to Board members that dates from the late 1990s, and documents related to fundraising.

SERIES II: OUTREACH

Series II is housed in folders 3-17 of Box 2. This material relates to such activities as Out in Westport and National Coming Out Day. The various newsletters generated by the Center and different Councils are also in this series. Items associated with various projects, volunteers, and the search for a building are in this series.

SERIES III: OFFICE FILES

The paperwork associated with the day-to-day operations of the Center is in Series III. This includes correspondence, forms, lists, and calendars. Materials from other organizations that was housed at and distributed by the Center are also in this series.

SERIES IV: PUBLICATIONS – LOCAL

Series IV contains commercial publications aimed at the lesbian and gay community and published in Kansas City. It also features guides from several Pride festivals and other programs from public events.

SERIES V: PUBLICATIONS – MISSOURI/KANSAS

Series V contains commercial publications aimed at the lesbian and gay community and published in Missouri or Kansas, outside of Kansas City.

SERIES VI: PUBLICATIONS – NATIONAL

Series VI features a variety of commercial and activist publications from across the country. Notable highlights include *Come Out*, a radical newspaper from New York City dating from 1969-70 (the first issue dates from six months after the Stonewall Rebellion) and *Her-Self*, a “community women’s newspaper” out of Ann Arbor, Michigan, dating from the mid-1970s.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

This portion of the Lesbian & Gay Community Center of Kansas City Collection was gifted to the Gay & Lesbian Archive of Mid-America sometime following the original donation in February, 2010. It contains materials related to the day to day operations of the Community Center such as manuals; marketing tools; meeting agendas; minutes; memberships and outreach ventures. There are organizational reports and informational data from affiliated groups such as Gay & Lesbian Alliance, as well as other Local and National initiatives.

Highlights in the collection can be found among the 387 photographs, some of which are featured throughout several scrapbooks. The scrapbooks are documentation of events of the Lesbian & Gay Community Center of Kansas City and the Lesbian & Gay Community Center of Kansas City OutSource, in addition to Phoenix Books and New Earth Bookstore.
